 detention incorporate a gender perspective into their work and address violence against
 women and girls in detention. Jointly published with the Association for the Prevention of
 Torture.
- Neglected needs: girls in the criminal justice system: A briefing that outlines the specific issues challenges for girls and recommendations to strengthen their protection.
- **Briefing**: Discrimination of women in criminal justice system: This briefing maps the concerns relating to discrimination of women as alleged offenders.
